

Digital Preservation Web Engineer

The purpose of the National Library is to enrich the cultural and economic life of New Zealand by collecting, preserving and protecting documents, particularly those relating to New Zealand, and making them accessible in a manner consistent with their status as documentary heritage and taonga.

Preservation Research & Consultancy (PRC) is a business unit within the Content Services Directorate. It manages the Library's digital preservation programme, supports digital collecting for the published collections of the National Library and the Alexander Turnbull Library (ATL), and supports the delivery of digital materials via the Library's various delivery channels.

The primary purpose of the Digital Preservation Web Engineer is to define, implement and support the efficient acquisition of web based digital content subject to the Library's Legal Deposit legislation. This role is responsible for managing complex analysis, and implementation of a high quality web harvesting programme comprising design, development, configuration and management of web archiving systems including discovery and access services.

This includes harvesting via the Library's selective and whole-of-domain web archiving programmes and the design, deployment and implementation of mechanisms for storing, indexing and providing access (including data mining) to the web collections.
